

# **The Old Newsboys of Flint's Christmas Box Program**

The Old Newsboys of Flint's Christmas Box Program is designed to be a safety net to provide gifts to children (from birth to age 18 *if still in high school*) who might otherwise go without.

**Online Enrollment Is Open October 30– December 15th, 2020 – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

**Our office hours are Mon-- Fri 8:00AM – 3:30PM-- closed between 12:00pm – 1:00pm.**

**BEGINNING ON NOVEMBER 4<sup>TH</sup>, AND CONTINUING ON WEDNESDAY'S ONLY – IN PERSON SIGN UP AT OLD NEWSBOYS FROM 8:00 AM – 3:30 PM, FOR THOSE WHO CANNOT SIGN UP ONLINE**

To apply to the program: Go Online to; [www.onbflint.org](http://www.onbflint.org), from there you will find a link. You will be provided with a confirmation of sign up and a notification of when to pick up your box. **OR** on WEDNESDAYS ONLY, the parent or legal guardian must come to the Old Newsboys office at 6255 Taylor Drive, Flint MI (Furthest south door on the west side of the building) during the scheduled enrollment times.

**The parent or legal guardian must have these DOCUMENTS TO ENROLL:**

1. Bring their Driver's License or Michigan State ID that proves residency in Genesee County.
2. Bring the Birth Certificates or Judgments of Legal Custody for each child enrolled.

**When you arrive...DUE TO COVID-19 MANDATES YOU ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK.**

- Understand that EVEN IF your children have received gifts from the Old Newsboys in the past, all of the above listed paper work must be provided each year they are enrolled.

**\*\*You may NOT sign up for more than one (similar service) agency during the Christmas season\*\***

We do have a partnership with TOYS FOR TOTS, and SALVATION ARMY where we will serve those children in your family who have aged out of their programs.

You **MUST** have a referral from those organizations.
