The Old Newsboys of Flint's Christmas Program

The Old Newsboys of Flint's Christmas Program is designed to be a safety net to provide gifts to children (from birth to age 18 *if still in high school*) who might otherwise go without.

Enrollment is open from November 3rd through December 19th. There will be NO online enrollment in 2025.

Our office hours are Mon-- Fri 8:00AM - 3:00PM-- closed between 12:00pm - 1:00pm.

To apply to the program: The **parent or legal guardian** must come to the Old Newsboys office at 6255 Taylor Drive, Flint MI (Furthest south door on the west side of the building) during the scheduled enrollment times.

The parent or legal guardian must have these DOCUMENTS TO ENROLL and PICK UP:

- 1. Bring their Driver's License or Michigan State ID that proves residency in Genesee County.
- 2. Bring the Birth Certificates or Judgments of Legal Custody for each child enrolled.
- Understand that EVEN IF your children have received gifts from the Old Newsboys in the past, all of the above listed paper work must be provided each year they are enrolled.

You may **NOT sign up for more than one (similar service) agency during the Christmas season**

We do have a partnership with TOYS FOR TOTS, where we will serve those children in your family who have aged out of their program.
